## COMMUNITY PRIORITY OPTIONS

### Health

1. Improve access and education around mental health.
2. Improve transportation to and from services.
3. Improve affordability of health services.

### Early Learning and Pre-K

4. Provide more competitive compensation for teachers.
5. Improve affordability of child care and Pre-K.
6. Improve the quality of child care and Pre-K.

### Kindergarten to Third Grade

7. Enhance supports for teachers to improve teacher quality.
8. Improve equitable access to resources.
9. Enhance whole-child supports, such as social-emotional learning, developmentally appropriate activities, etc.
10. Enhance relationships among schools, communities, and parents.

### Family Support

11. Improve resource / referral pathways.
12. Improve relationship-based service delivery (to be more respectful, culturally-competent, equitable, etc.).

### Cross Sector and Systems

13. Enhance data collection and sharing among organizations.
14. Improve service coordination across sectors.
15. Increase prevalence of specific supports to break the cycle of poverty.
